Thank you for your interest in partnering with us as we continue to provide the Chicagoland community with World-class gymnastics instruction in a safe and positive environment. Currently, we have two **U.S. National Team members**, **Elizabeth Tricase** and **Kristina Comforte**, who are both training to earn a spot on the **2004 U.S. Olympic Team** to represent the United States in Athens, Greece. Additionally, we have had more than 55 athletes earn "full-ride" college scholarship for gymnastics. Our current facility in Westmont, the only **U.S. National Team Training Center** in Illinois, offers the most advanced training systems available. After only three years in our new location, approximately 1200 children, ages 18 months to 18 years, attend classes on a weekly basis. Our target for the 2004-2005 season is to exceed 1700 students. In addition to gymnastics, we offer cheerleading, tumbling, trampoline, birthday parties, field trips and even summer day camps. Each year, we also host the LARGEST artistic gymnastics meet in the world, the **Chicago Style Invitational**, held inside Navy Pier in Chicago. In February of 2004, more than 3700 athletes registered to compete.
